Something was killing the Sosian chickens every night so we put the camera trap up outside the hen-house, first mug shot is Havoc the cat on patrol. 3 hours later the culprit arrived and dug under the house and a new wire fence. Next day spotted again before disappearing. Honey badgers are famously fierce and courageous and not one to be put off easily, he tore the corrugated iron roof off the hen-house and killed another few chickens! The hen-house is now a fortified jail with reinforced steel roof cemented onto thick stone walls dug 1 metre into the ground. The Sosian chickens produce 50 eggs a day and we can't have our guests missing out on Eggs Benedicte or Chocolate Fondant!



July and August are almost full but we have plenty of space in September and October. We have just had a cancellation at Christmas and have 2 rooms available from 25th – 31st December ideal for a family. We have had lots of rain in June and Sosian is covered in plains game and elephants.
